Accommodation:

- In Florence: twin-bedded rooms in student residence with private bathroom, access to paid laundry facilities, shared kitchen, and common spaces.
- In Parma and Rome and final night in Florence: twin- or triple-bedded rooms in a centrally located tourist-class hotel with Wi-Fi (1 night in Parma, 2 nights in Rome, 1 night in Florence).

- Orientation program in Florence consisting of a meeting with AIFS staff, information on safety and security, and cultural activities.

- Reserved entrance to Palazzo Vecchio.

Refund policy and important dates to remember should you need to cancel your participation:
